# Ideas for Home and Parish

- **Embrace slow travel:** see your own country and only fly when you have to. Go by train, bus, car, bike, walking shoes. Consider car sharing or carpooling. Choose a smaller car when replacing.
- As **gas appliances** wear out, replace with electric that can be powered using renewable energy sources.
- Install solar panels if you can. Compare energy providers and choose the cleanest.
- Improve energy efficiency: insulate ceilings, block draughts, turn off appliances at the wall at night.

# **ACTIVELY PROTECT AND IMPROVE**

Many people taking small steps adds up to a big impact. Reducing emissions is important. Be active in your home, workplace, community and parish life. Look for ways to Reduce - Refuse -Reuse - Repair - Recycle - Repurpose - Review.

- Limit heating/cooling temperatures: Save energy and costs by setting heating in winter to 18-20 degrees and cooling in summer to 22-23 degrees.
- **Reduce consumption**, look for secondhand or borrow what you need.
- Grow some of your food if you can, look for locally produced food, join or start a food co-op.
- **Refuse plastic** when you can, re-use, repair, recycle.
- Review your banks and superannuation providers and switch to those that support clean energy
