

## Everyday Evangelism – YouTube training with Dr. Steven Abbott

Everyday Evangelism is a useful course to reexamine what it means to evangelise. Rather than focusing on creating a catchy evangelistic tool, Dr Steven Abbott reminds all believers that we are called to share our faith with others. In this course he looks at how we do that in ways which are intentional and relational. He reminds us of the simplicity of the Gospel message. He also provides several apologetic tools and resources but encourages each believer to be sensitive, kind and gentle in how we approach those seeking and to listen and understand where they are on their journey in life. We thank Dr Abbott for providing the work booklet for part one to download.

He covers issues such as:

What are God’s principles in how we need to share our faith and why we should do that.

Course designed to become more intentional and deliberate in how you do your everyday life.

Willing and obedient heart, being before doing (relationship) Matthew 5:13-16 salt and light.

Most Christians have lost the capacity to talk about our faith. If we cannot talk to each other how going to do that outside the church...

The course is a set of four sessions which run for nearly two hours each. An overview of the topics covered is as follows:

Topic One: You are wired for witness: Introduction to evangelism for all believers. Evangelism is about relationship.

Two: Sharing your story: this session covers fears about evangelism and ‘What is a testimony’ and why it is such a powerful tool.

Three: Getting the facts straight – What is the Gospel message and what are the blockages in your church and gives tools and resources for discussing your faith with people from various backgrounds and with limited faith knowledge.

Topic Four: Handling tough questions...– looks in detail at some of the arguments against Christianity today and provides answers and resources for engaging with non-believers. He also provides advice for our attitudes to sharing the Gospel and a reminder that it is the ‘power of God unto salvation’.
